Chisholm To Speak To Women's Forum

Congresswoman Shirley Chisholm (D. Bklyn., N.Y.) will join a prestigious panel of outstanding women when the upcoming conference of the Women's Forum, Inc. is held on February 6, at New York's Marymount Manhattan College.

Sponsored by Avon Products, Inc., the Conference on "Change: The Issues at Stake" will explore critical public policy issues facing society and business in the

NAACP Elections Held

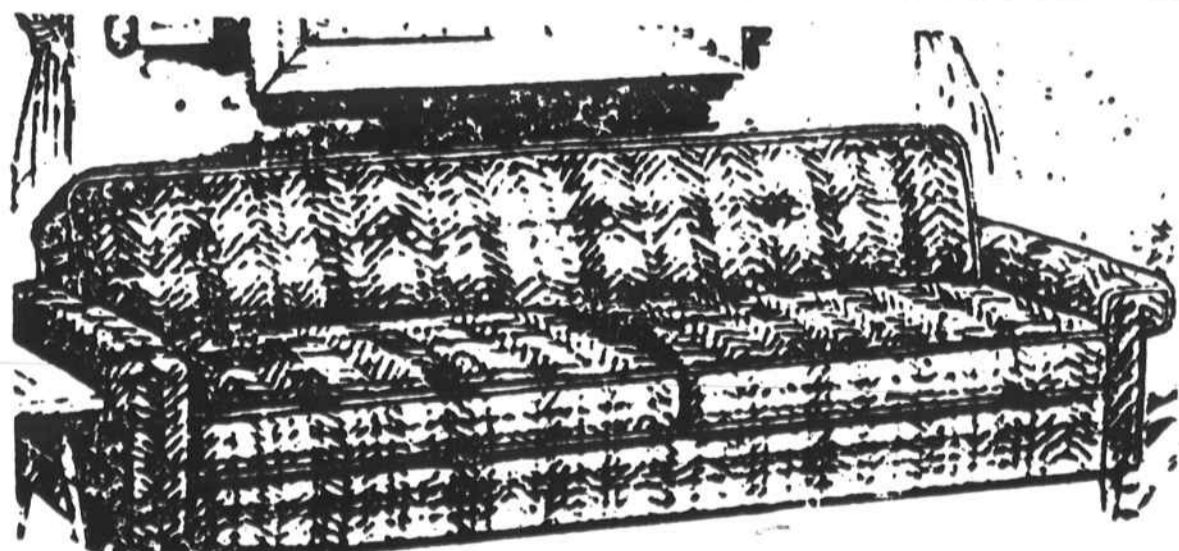

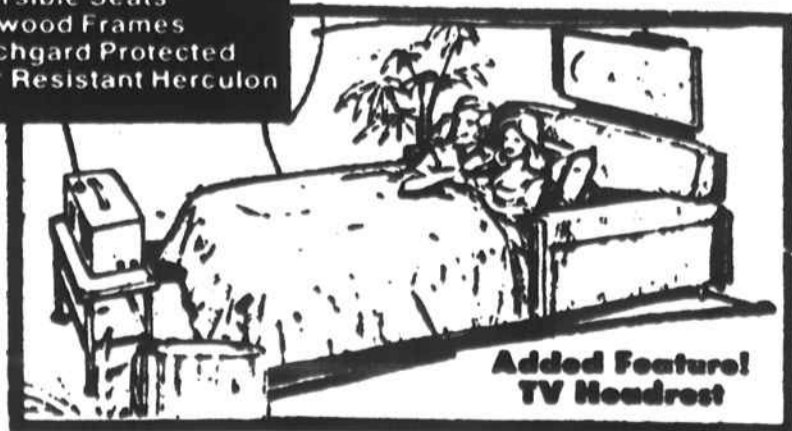
