

# Commission Discusses Noise

In response to a request by Alderman Larry Little representing the residents of the Shorefair Drive area, the Dixie Classic Fair Commission held a public hearing Tuesday to discuss fallout and noise problems resulting from fireworks displays held at the fairgrounds.

Alderman Little and Mrs. Betty Manning, President of the Shorefair Drive Neighborhood Association, were the area residents who came to the hearing.

Alderman Little apologized for not sufficiently advising the residents of the area of the hearing. He added that he had attended stacked hearing where a huge crowd attended and feared that he would be penalized, both by the Presidents and the commissioners for the poor turnout.

Little summarized the complaints from the area as excessive noise, damage to property (mostly automobiles) noise at a late hour and fear of a serious fire due to fallout. He mentioned a child in the area having a nervous condition due to the noise and the family moving from the area.

When Mrs. Manning arrived, she mentioned similar complaints, saying the conditions were intolerable. She spoke of complaints for the past 13 years and recalled that the fireworks were moved to Ernie Shore Field for one year. She said that things fall out which are unexploded and that debris was very common throughout the area after a firing.

Mr. Zambelli said that every major city and every major fair has fireworks and that they are becoming bigger. He mentioned that

fireworks are sound and sight. He said that the noise and fallout could be eliminated but that would take some of the excitement away from the event. He said that the possibility is very remote that an unexploded shell would be propelled into the area.

Austin said that the wind was very unfavorable last year. That only once had the firing extended past 10:30. He said that the firing has been moved nearer the fair office so that most of the shaft would fall in the fairground area. Also the firing is now confined between 10:00 and 10:20 p.m., two fire units are on hand, and that fair employees are stationed near the fence to observe fall out. Cleanup crews police the area the following morning. Austin said that if winds are unfavorable, the fair works could be cancelled for that evening.

Zambelli said that this company has had no claims for personal injury. He said that he would put in writing his plan to meet the area complaints and have it back to the fair office within a week.

The Fair Commission will be back in touch with area residents prior to its June meeting and outline steps which will be taken to address their complaints.

Lewis Graham, Chairman of the Commission, presided. Other commission members in attendance were Miss Nancy Wilson, Carl Livengood, Dr. C.B. Hauser, Dr. Bernell Jones, Richard Barron, and John Idol.

Others in an official capacity present were W.B. Austin, FAIR Manager, Mrs. Della Hester, Fair Secretary, Joe Berrier, Assistant City Manager, and George Zambelli, president of Zambelli Fireworks for the fair.






