finished the basic training, she was employed in the University's Data Processing Center.

Ms. Jones worked in soft money positions at Winston-Salem State until 1977 when the soft money for her employment was no longer available.

During 1977-78, Ms. Jones' dream was deferred for a time but she kept it alive as she existed on unemployment insurance and work as a part time data punch operator in Kernersville.

Things began looking up again when she was employed at Western Electric in 1978 as a data entry technician. Last fall, she heard of the East Winston Restoration Association's project of building homes for low and moderate income families in the East Winston area. She applied for one of the homes.

With counseling and assistance from the Western Electric Credit Union; Vanessa Rawls,

Neighborhood Association Advisor with the Community Development Department; and Mrs. Gloria C. Goore, Volunteer Coordinator of the East Winston Restoration Association, Ms. Jones now has an approved application for one of the six Section 235 homes the association is to build, and she has a commitment from a lender for mortgage money to finance the deal.

By the middle of June, Ms. Jones and her 12 year old daughter, Stephanie, hope to be in their new home. "I am so happy," Ms. Jones said, "Everyone has been so nice and helpful to me. I can hardly wait until June."

The East Winston Restoration Association is the first Neighborhood Association in North Carolina to work with a municipality to develop Section 235 houses for low and moderate income families. Before the Section 235 Program was discontinued in January, the East Winston Restoration Association was approved to build six houses under the program. Each house will sell for around \$38,000.00.




