Frankie Smith

After several years of touring as a performer, Frankie Smith entered the limelight in 1977 as a songwriter for Philadelphia International Records. While there, he accumulated an impressive list of top songwriting credits writing tunes for such artists as Archie Bell and the Drells, Billy Paul, Melba Moore, DeeDee Sharp, The Futures, Jean Carn, and Mike Pedicin, Jr. Shortly after his first song "Hard Not To Like You" was recorded by Archie Bell and the Drells, Frankie was given the opportunity to produce as well as write for these artists.



Currently, Frankie Smith is signed to WMOT Records as an artist/writer/producer. His first release "Double Dutch Bus" was co-written and produced by Bill Bloom who has written and produced for artists such as the Jones Girls and Jerry Butler. "Double Dutch Bus" is a unique record which describes the hot-test new dance craze sweeping the country called "Double Dutch." It is actually a choreographed jump-rope game with a language and style all its own that originated on the streets of Frankie's home town of Philadelphia.



"Kids use their mom's clotheslines and talk in 'pig latin' or 'slang' or 'splog' so that they can talk over the grown-

ups' heads," says Frankie. "Double Dutch Bus" is a salute to all the

kids who turn and jump Double Dutch rope. It has become part of the

norm. It is a real skill, it's not just done for fun anymore."

Sheinwold on Backgammon

DON'T BE FRIGHTENED

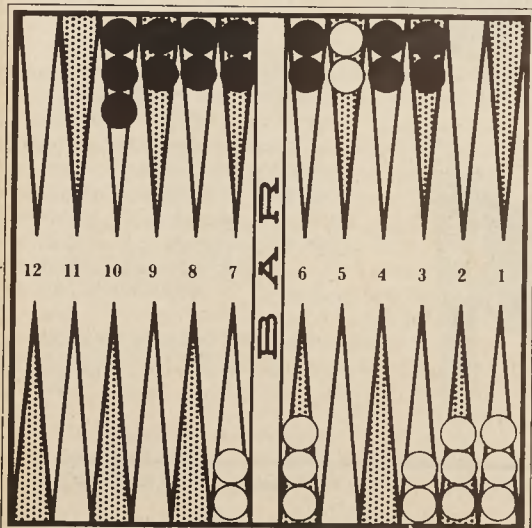
In the diagrammed position it is Black's turn to roll, and he doubles. Should you accept the double, or should you resign? You are trapped behind a 5-point prime, but don't be frightened. Take the double. Black must move into his home board, and each time he releases an outside point it becomes easier for you to get out. While you are waiting for a roll with two nice big numbers, you can move the men on your bar point and your 6-point. Unless you roll a doublet, you can probably make three or four safe moves without having to touch the trapped men. If both sides get normal rolls, you have an excellent chance to get your back men out; and you will then be ahead in the race. You may

well find yourself with a sound redouble in the fullness of time. You wouldn't accept the double if you were behind in the race since you would then have to get your back men out safely and also catch up. But when you are ahead in the race, all you need is a fairly big roll at any time in your next four rolls to gain a winning position.

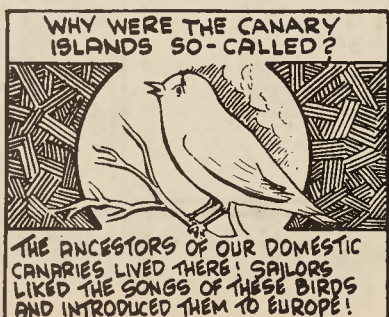

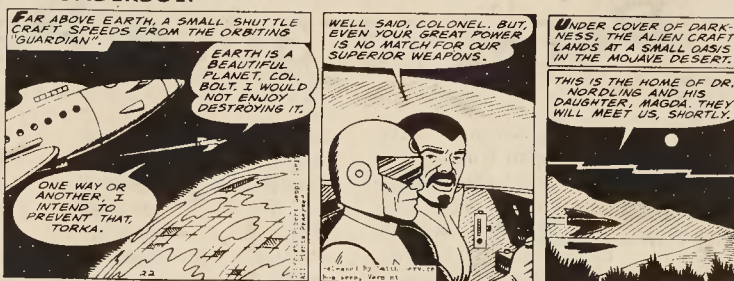
