NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

WINSTON-SALEM TRANSIT AUTHORITY proposal to reduce and raise fares to become effective 08/31/81

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Winston-Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) in the Council Chambers of the Winston-Salem City Hall at 4:00 P.M. and 7:30 P.M. Tuesday August 11, 1981 for the purpose of considering the reduction of bus services and a change in pass and commuter fares.

DESCRIPTION:

The proposed route changes will result in approximately 22% reduction of service. Duplications of services will be eliminated and poorly used services will be reduced.

The proposed increase calls for no increases in the basic adult fares which will remain at 50¢. The express fare will be increased from 80¢ to 75¢. Transfers for cash fares will remain as is. However, the monthly pass for the handicapped will increase from \$8.00 to \$10.00, effective during non-peak hours only (9:30 A.M. thru 3:30 P.M.). The ten-ride pass will remain at \$4.75. The monthly pass will increase from \$16.00 to \$18.00. The Kernersville and Clemmons Commuter passes will go to \$35.00. The King Commuter pass will cost \$40.00 per month. The Oldtown Commuter will become an express service with the proposed 75¢ per ride.

These funds will support WSTA service throughout its service area, generally the City of Winston-Salem and its environs.

In an opinion of the Comptroller General of the United States, WSTA buses are available for incidental charter service within the designated service area. This service will not interfere with regularly scheduled mass transportation services. WSTA agrees that neither it, nor any operator of mass transportation equipment on its behalf, will engage in any charter bus operation where points of origin or destination will be outside of the designated service area as established by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina, amended February 25, 1974.

RELOCATION:

No persons, families or businesses will be displaced by this project.

ENVIRONMENT:

The proposal will not have a significant environmental impact on the urban area.

COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING:

The proposed project is in conformance with comprehensive land use and transportation plans for the area.

ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED:

The proposed project will allow the continuance of transit services, now provided, including a half-fare rates for the elderly and handicapped during non-peak hours.

At the hearing, the Winston-Salem Transit Authority will afford opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard with respect to the social, economic and environmental aspects of the project. Interested persons may submit orally or in writing evidence and recommendations with respect to said project.

A copy of the proposed fare increase is currently available for public inspection at Transit Authority Headquarters, 1060 N. Trade Street, Winston-Salem, N.C.
