**'Nobody Is Going To Save Us But Ourselves'**

Dr. G.L. Bowick, Pittsburgh, PA was re-elected President of the Lott Carey Baptist Foreign Mission Convention at the Raddison Plaza Hotel, in it's 84th annual session, meeting on Aug. 31 through Sept. 4, 1981.

Other officers elected were Dr. Benjamin Robertson, Richmond, VA; First Vice President; Dr. James A. Scott, Newark, NJ, Second Vice President; Dr. J. Jasper Freeman, Norfolk, VA, Secretary; Dr. C.W. Ward, Raleigh, NC, Assistant Secretary; Rev. James L. Cherry, Rochester, NY Statistician.

Mrs. Helen V. Benton, Baltimore, MD was returned as head of the Women's Auxiliary. Dennis R. Hawkins was elected to head the Laymen's Dept. and Mrs. Doris Griffith will supervise the Youth Dept. She is the mother of Max Robinson, Anchorman for ABC television network. Dr. W.C.
