

# Using Your Iron

--Choose an iron that has a movable cord which can accomodate both a righthanded and left-handed

--After you have finished ironing, coil the cord and Tripping over the cord or place the iron out of reach of children to cool.


--Remember to unplug the iron and place it out of Another common accident reach of children even if you leave for only a few minutes.
