the Reynolds reply, the more than 30 residents at the meeting questioned Little about the relocation procedures and laws. Little said that he felt that the

residents had accomplished something, since an option-to-buy provision had been added to the relocation regulations. The provision furnishes funds for relocating residents who qualify to buy private housing. "A lot of you wondered why we did not jump at the first offer that Reynolds made," Little told the group. "It did work out to some advantage in that now some of you who want to buy your homes will be given the opportunity to do so."

Little also emphasized that only those residents on the east side of Patterson Avenue would be affected by the relocation process at this time. "One of the things that I don't like about this situa-

tion is that it is sitting on pins and needles" he said. "If your house has not been purchased by Reynolds, or has not been condemned, then I don't know when you will have to move. In some situations, it may be a while. I just don't know at this time."

Not only is housing in Liberty-Patterson being effected by Reynolds' expansion, Little told the residents, but many of the businesses in the neighborhood must be relocated as well. "I'm not sure exactly how the businesses will be affected," Little commented. "That's another thing about this situation that I don't like. It's the businesses that are really getting shafted in this deal."

## Quick Cures For Minor Appliance Breakdowns

The next time your appliance has a breakdown, don't be too quick to call the serviceman. You may be able to get it running again and save a costly service call. Here's a short, basic troubleshooting checklist for several of the major appliances in your home: washers, dryers, ranges and garbage disposers.

If you can't solve the problem and the equipment is still under a warranty, call the dealer where you purchased the machine. An "unauthorized" repair person could invalidate the warranty, warns the Better Business Bureau.

If the warranty has expired, check with your local Better Business Bureau for reliability information on the service center that you have selected. Give the repair center the name and model number of the appliance and a description of what you think might be wrong with it. Above all, don't tear into the machine to try and find the trouble.

### Troubleshooting Washers

When a washer breaks down, the problem usually is electrical, not mechanical. Make these checks:

- Is the machine receiving power? Check the power cord. Then check for blown fuses or tripped circuit breakers at the main electrical entrance to your home. If you own an older home, there may be two power entrances. If the circuit is not the problem but fuses/breakers continue to pop, make sure the machine is not overloaded with detergent and/or wash.
- Push the reset button on the control panel or motor.
- Make sure the timer is properly set in the right sequence.

### Electric/Gas Ranges

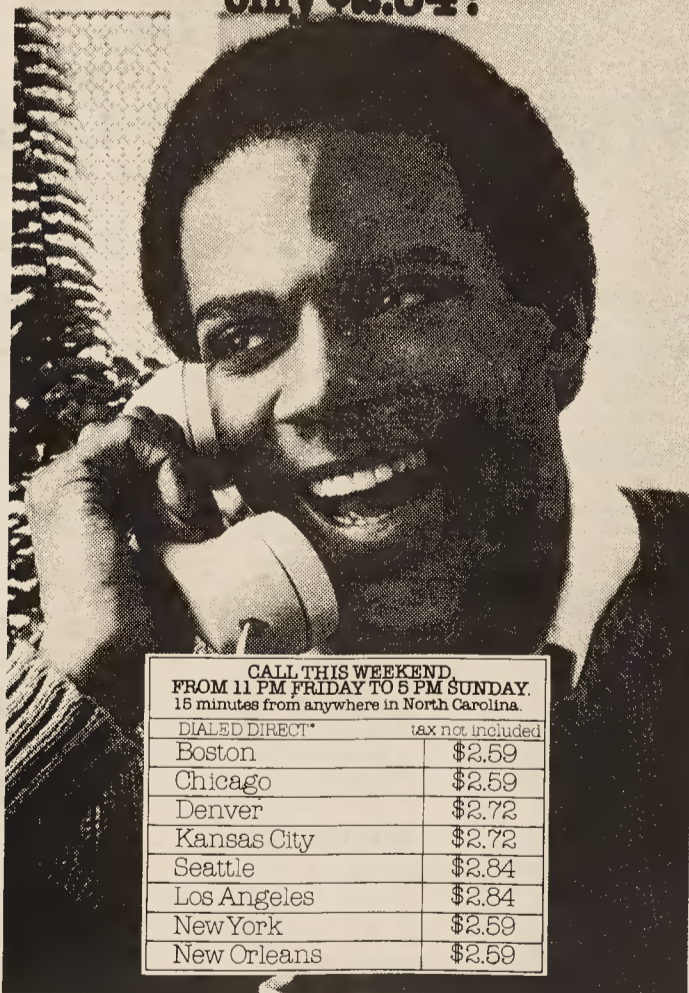
Check the power source first. Some ranges are double-fused; one side of the breaker or fuse panel may be blown if the power is inadequate. Lift an element at the back of the range or look in the oven to find the fuse.

- If the range is gas-powered and the burners

won't light, make sure the gas valve is open. If the range has an electric ignition, check the power cord and main electrical service entrance for blown fuses and/or tripped breakers.

- If the burners won't light, they may be dirty. Clean the burner ports with a fine piece of wire or a sewing needle. Don't use a wooden match stick; the stick can break off in the ports and clog them.
