

Read Contracts, Know Refund Policies Before You Buy

Most reputable retailers have a liberal refund and exchange policy that you should know about before buying any item that may have to be exchanged at a later date.

Bureau, that stores are not obligated to accept items for refund, exchange or credit except in certain cases. Some stores have "no return" or "final sale" policies. Some states require stores by law to

disclose clearly what their return policies are. You do have return privileges, says the BBB, if the products you purchased were misrepresented or defective. The store should provide a suitable substitute or refund and even make

repairs free. The laws in all states require a store to make good in such cases. However, in many areas health regulations forbid returns of such items as hats, bathing suits and other intimate apparel. And, some stores may

charge a restocking fee for returns. Most retailers are very liberal about "honest mistakes" on those items that don't fit or match or serve the purpose for which they were purchased. For example, if that shirt Uncle

Floyd gave you for Christmas doesn't fit, the store where the shirt was bought most likely will exchange it for one that does. But don't expect a cash refund for the shirt unless you have a receipt. It's very important that

goods to be exchanged (and even cash refunds) be accompanied by the cash register receipt from the store where the purchase was made. This policy has been adopted by many stores to discourage shoplifting.

If a written contract is involved in a purchase, be sure that you read and understand it thoroughly before you sign it. Never sign a blank contract, and always keep a copy of the contract that you did sign.
