nurses' station is open for better visibility; floors are carpeted for noise control; rooms are color accented; and two corridors divide adolescents from younger patients.

Dr. Charlie Kennedy is chief of pediatrics and Mrs. Ollie Taylor is nurse coordinator. Almost 1,800 children were provided care in the pediatric unit last year.
