"Team Spirit '84" is an exercise involving the military forces of the United States and the Republic of Korea. More than 210,000 people from all branches of the U.S. Armed Forces and from the Republic of Korea are participating in the month-long exercise, including 27,000 people and 26 ships from the U.S. Seventh Fleet.

During "Team Spirit," units are participating in various naval exercises. It will end with a major amphibious assault on the southeastern coast of the Republic of Korea.

The 360-foot, 6,900-ton submarines are well equipped to accomplish the mission of hunting down and destroying enemy surface ships and submarines. Each vessel carries a crew of 127, all specialists in their respective field.
