look as bad as the old if joints are not properly prepared.

New grout must bond to existing grout and tiles. This requires removing loose grout, cleaning the joints out to a depth of at least one-eighth inch and forming a flat-bottomed trench. Be careful about using metal tools, because they leave marks and chip the tile edges. Goggles are a must when you are chipping out grout. Do not leave loose bits of grout in joints. They will weaken new grout and spoil a smooth finish. Use a vacuum to pick up all debris. You can mix your own grout or buy premixed tubes at builder supply stores. Don't use detergent on the surface of tile or grout for about 30 days after installation.

The community Development Department of the City of Winston-Salem and the Housing Authority of Winston-Salem seek proposals for the use of up to thirty-seven (37) Section 8-certificates for the rehabilitation of housing units. The Moderate Rehabilitation program is a federally subsidized housing program for very low and lower income households. Through the program, a fifteen year subsidy is provided through Section 8 certificates. Thirty-seven (37) units must consist of up to four (4) three bedroom units; up to seven (7) one bedroom units; and/or up to twenty-six (26) two bedroom units or a mixture of all three sizes.

The structures must be located in the following specific census tracts: 1, 2, 3.01, 3.02, 4, 5.01, 5.02, 6, 7, 8.01, 8.02, 11 (east of Peter's Creek Parkway only), 14, 15, 16.01, 16.02, 17, 18, 19.01, or 33.03.

Each proposal must include a fifteen year cash flow analysis and documentation of financial feasibility. Owner/Developers must comply with all local and state laws and ordinances such as zoning and parking requirements. Information contained in proposals is not confidential and will be reviewed for comment by certain community organizations.
