Evangelist Sarah C. Rowdy is the pastor.



## Dr. Proctor is featured guest

Dr. Samuel D. Proctor, former president of North Carolina A&T State and Virginia Union universities, will be the guest speaker Sunday, Aug. 19 at the 11 a.m. worship service at Shiloh Baptist Church during its 92nd anniversary observance.

A 6:15 p.m. service will also be held.

Dr. Proctor, now senior minister of Abyssinian Baptist Church in New York City, is professor of education at the Rutgers University Graduate School of Education in New Brunswick, N.J. He holds degrees from Virginia Union University and Boston University.

He has held administrative positions with the United State Peace Corps in Nigeria and Washington.

The distinguished speaker is also a member of the governing boards of the United Negro College Fund, Meharry Medical College, Wilberforce University, the Pension Board of American Baptists, the Institute for Poverty Research, the Overseas Development Council, the Institute for Services to Education, the John Dewey Association, and Middlesex General Hospital.

He is also the author of "The Young Negro in America 1960-80."

In addition to his many accomplishments, Proctor was named outstanding alumnus at Boston University in 1966. Some of the honorary doctorate degrees that have been conferred on him include the University of Maryland, University of Rhode Island, Atlanta University, Wilberforce University, David-
