Description of Project: The Project consists of land acquisition. construction and furnishings for a public transportation center to be located at Third and Main Streets, purchase of two supervisory vehicles, purchase of four specialty transit vehicles, project administration and contingency. The project cost is currently estimated at \$4.344,455 of which \$1,000 will be revenue financing from the sale of two supervisory vehicles. It is proposed that the City of Winston-Salem contribute \$434,346, the North Carolina Department of Transportation contribute \$434,345, and that \$4,344,455 will come from either UMTA

These funds will support WSTA service throughout its service area. generally the City of Winston-Salem and its immediate environs

Pursuant to an opinion of the Comptroller General of the United States. WSTA buses are available for incidental charter service within the designated service area. This service will not interfere with regularly duled mass transportation survices. WSTA agrees that neither it ner any operator of mass transportation equipment on its behalf will engage in any charter bus operations where points of origin or destination will be outside of the designated service area as established by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina, amended February 25.




