RE: Winston-Salem Transit Authority request to UMTA for a capital grant in the amount of \$3,343,455

1. Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of Winston-Salem and the Winston-Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) at the Winston-Salem Transit Authority Conference Room, 1060 N. Trade Street, at 12:15 p.m., Friday, December 15, 1984, for the purpose of considering a project for which financial assistance is being sought from the Urban Mass Transportation Administration, pursuant to the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, generally described as follows:

A. Description of Project: The Project consists of land acquisition, construction and furnishings for a public transportation center to be located at Third and Main Streets, purchase of two supervisory vehicles, purchase of four specialty transit vehicles, project administration and contingency. The project cost is currently estimated at \$4,344,455 of which \$1,000 will be revenue financing from the sale of two supervisory vehicles. It is proposed that the City of Winston-Salem contribute \$434,346, the North Carolina Department of Transportation contribute \$434,345, and that \$4,344,455 will come from either UMTA Section 5, 9 or 9A funds.

These funds will support WSTA service throughout its service area, generally the City of Winston-Salem and its immediate environs.

Pursuant to an opinion of the Comptroller General of the United States, WSTA buses are available for incidental charter service within the designated service area. This service will not interfere with regularly scheduled mass transportation services. WSTA agrees that neither it nor any operator of mass transportation equipment on its behalf will engage in any charter bus operations where points of origin or destination will be outside of the designated service area as established by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina, amended February 25, 1974.

B. Relocation: No persons or families will be displaced by this project. The existing parking deck will be purchased from the existing owners.

C. Environment: The proposed project is in conformance with comprehensive land use and transportation plans for the area. An environmental assessment has been completed for the project and concluded that there will be no significant adverse environmental impacts from the project.

D. Elderly and Handicapped: The proposed project will allow the continuation of transit and Trans-AID services as now provided, including half-fare rates for the elderly and handicapped.

2. At the hearing, the Winston-Salem Transit Authority will afford an opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard with respect to the social, economic and environmental aspects of the project. Interested persons may submit orally or in writing evidence and recommendations with respect to said project.

A copy of the applications for this federal grant, the environmental assessment for the project, and the transit development plan for the area are currently available for public inspection at the Winston-Salem Transit Authority offices, at 1060 N. Trade Street, Winston-Salem, North Carolina.
