Nominees are sought for boards

Mayor Wayne A. Corpening says he is seeking volunteers or nominees to fill vacancies on two commissions, the Dixie Classic Fairgrounds Commission and the Historic Properties Commission.

The Dixie Classic Fairgrounds Commission is a nine-member body which sets policy for all aspects of the fairground's operation. It meets quarterly and members are appointed to three-year terms. The deadline for submitting nominations is Dec. 31.

The Historic Properties Commission is a nine-member body which meets every third Wednesday night. It is responsible for safeguarding historical property throughout Forsyth County. Of special concern is property significant culturally, socially, economically, politically or architecturally. The deadline for submitting nominations to the commission is Jan. 15.

Nominations for either commission should be mailed to the Mayor's Office, Post Office Box 2511, Winston-Salem, N.C. 27102 and should include information about the nominee's qualifications for the post.
