Exporting Bigotry

"North Carolina is also export-
ing this bigotry to other states in
the region," said Mab Segrest,
coordinator of NCARRV. In
1985, she said, South Carolina
had at least six rallies led by
Klans based in North Carolina
(and seven illegal/violent in-
cidents).

According to the ordinance,
"the court may grant as relief as
it deems appropriate any perma-
nent or temporary injunction or
may grant a temporary restrain-
ing order or other orders."

The ordinance says the court

may award to the plaintiff actual
damages including compensation
for humiliation and embarrass-
ment. Not more than \$1,000 in
punitive damages can be award-
ed, along with court costs and
reasonable attorneys' fees, the
ordinance reads.

August, Falwell declared that
Bishop Desmond Tutu was a
"phony"; his *Moral Majority*
Report runs advertisements for
the sale of South African Kruger-
rands, the gold coins that sym-
bolize apartheid repression. He
claims that the Botha regime "is
doing its best to keep the land
free and preventing it from
becoming another Ethiopia."

Half-forgotten, perhaps, are
Falwell's statements 22 years ago,
during the American civil rights
movement. In 1965, Falwell
declared, "The true Negro does
not want integration." He
described the Jim Crow system as
"alleged discrimination." Falwell
criticized Martin Luther
King Jr. for his "left-wing
associations" and insisted that

civil rights "demonstrations and
marches have done more to
damage race relations and gender
hate than to help."

Democracy is meaningless if it
is compromised by systemic
racial inequality, political
disfranchisement, poverty and
police brutality. Martin Luther
King gave his life to the fulfill-
ment of effective power and
social justice for black
Americans. And, within that
vision of human equality, in a dif-
ferent social context, the people
of South Africa are attempting to
realize the same dream of
freedom.

In July, nine members of a
White Patriot Party unit in
Belglade, Fla., were arrested for
assaulting two black men with
nail-spiked ax handles, striking
another with a car and shooting a
pellet gun into an occupied fast-
food restaurant used by black
people.

The growing paramilitary em-
phasis of hate groups in the state,
and their connection to the most
violent groups nationwide, was
the most disturbing development
in 1985, according to the report.
