Such rhetoric, if implemented by any president, would lead to egal anarchy, at best. GOP officials, including many ultrarightists, shudder privately at the prospect of Robertson at he head of their 1988 ticket.

If Bush falters 1987, as many spect, look for Kansas Sen. Robert Dole to pick up most of nis followers.

Dole has some obvious grengths. As Senate majority eader, he has media visibility; he as directed the Reagan administration's reactionary agenda brough Congress. Dole also acjuired some national campaign experience back in 1976 as the GOP vice presidential candidate.

Some Democrats are more earful of Dole's potential candacy than that of any other epublican, because of his eputation as a "compassionate onservative."

But this reputation is more illuon than reality. Last month, for kample, Dole wanted to support liberal amendment which would ave given \$62 million in unexended Pentagon money to mior citizens' program. But hen the roll call showed a narw vote, Dole shelved his prinples by voting no. The necessity be viewed as heartless in the arch for a Great White Hope as more important than the aterial needs of the elderly.

But if all of the above run into fficulties, other Republicans re waiting hungrily in the wings. In late August, Reaganites in he western states met in Oregon plot the presidential campaign conservative Republican Sen. aul Laxalt of Nevada. Other sser Reagan epigones with esidential ambitions include elaware Gov. Pete du Pont, rmer Defense Secretary Donald umsfeld, former Sen. Howard aker of Tennessee and Colado Sen. William Armstrong. All desperately want the oportunity to become America's xt Great White Hope.
