Marine 1st Lt. **David A. Peacock** recently participated in exercise Northern Wedding/Bold Guard '86.

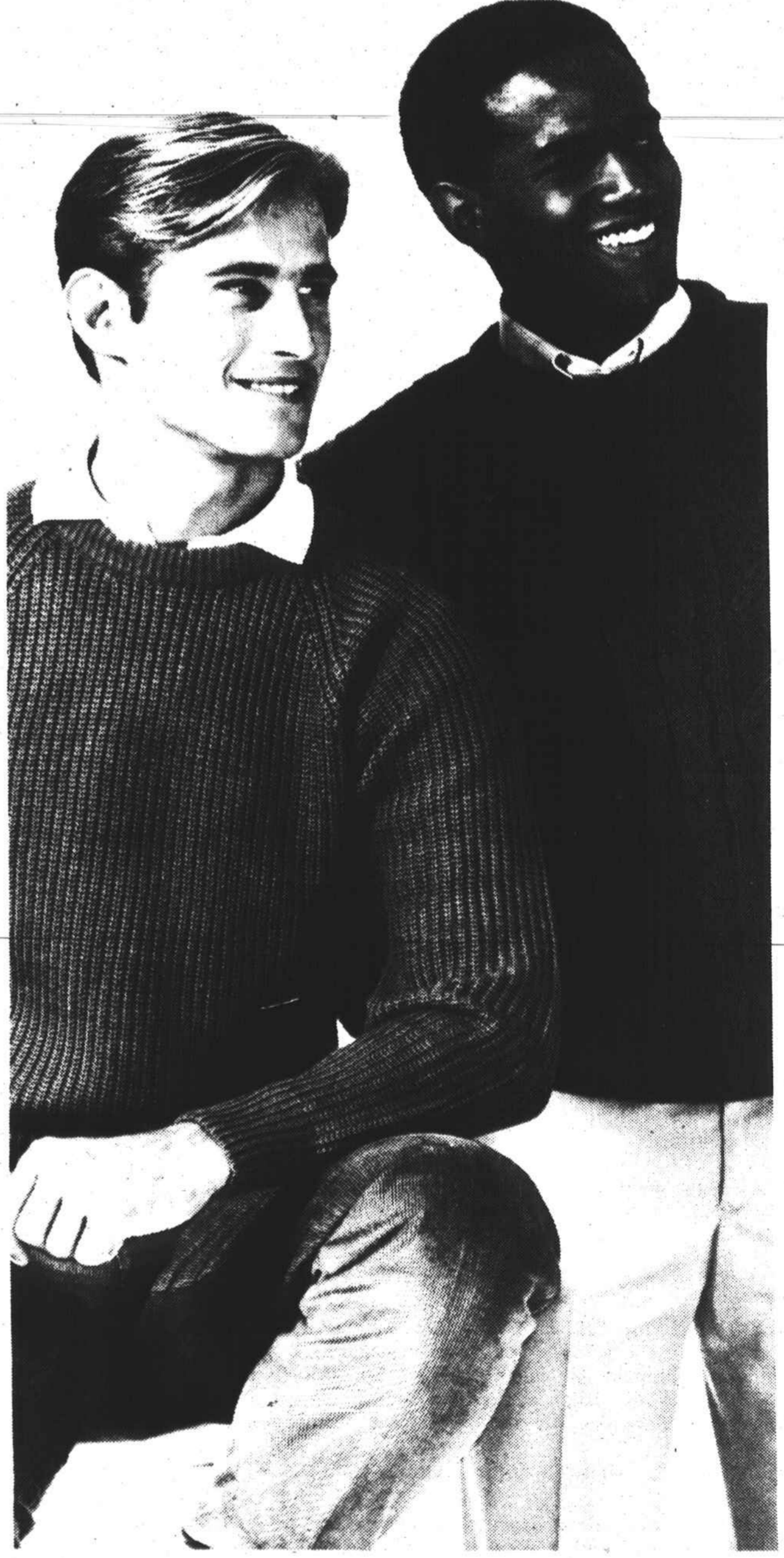
