Recipe

2 large red onions, thinly sliced
safflower oil
Freshly ground pepper
4 sprigs each rosemary and thyme, or 1 teaspoon each of the dried herbs
salt

Marinade:
1/2 cup olive oil
1/2 cup red wine vinegar
1 tablespoon balsamic vinegar
salt
freshly ground pepper

To prepare marinade: Whisk the ingredients together and pour over onions in a shallow glass pan or plastic bag. Marinate 2 hours or more, tossing occasionally to be sure onions are thoroughly coated.

To prepare salmon steaks, rub them with safflower oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper to

taste. Place 1 sprig rosemary and thyme (or a pinch of dried herbs) on top of each steak. Refrigerate until ready to cook.

To barbecue, place salmon on grill and cover. Cook 6 minutes; turn and cook 6 or 7 minutes longer, or until salmon is cooked through. Serve on warm platter with marinated onions. Garnish with fresh sprigs of rosemary. Serves 6.
