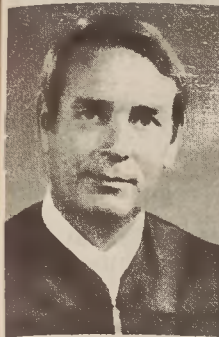


Candidates throw hats into '88 vote arena

Etheridge to run for State Superintendent

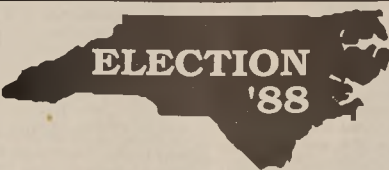


Esposito

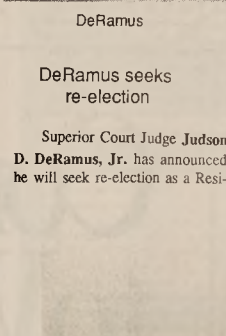
