Dreamers come in two varieties: wishful thinkers and visionaries. But what separates those who just wish from those who manifest their dreams? An education, for one thing.

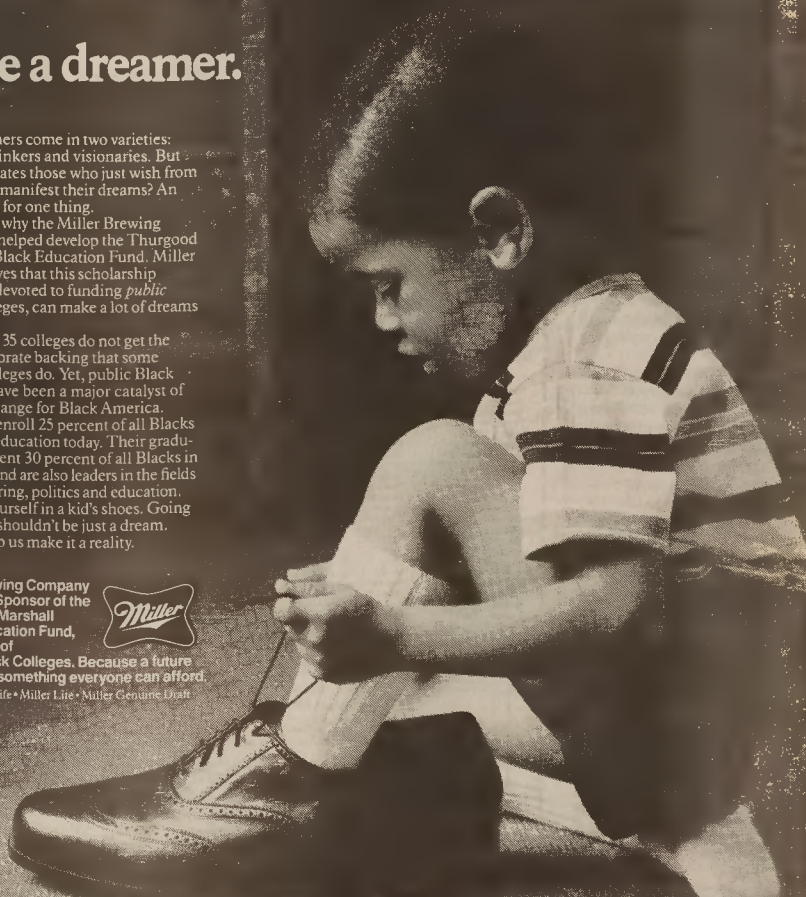
