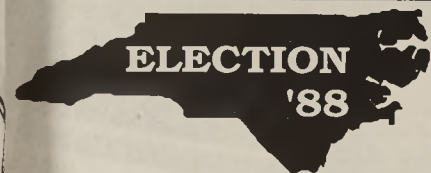

The Board will also consider the following zoning text amendments:

1. Proposal of Bethabara Hills to amend "Section 25-6.(G)" of the City Code regarding the one-half mile spacing requirement between "Family Care Homes." The amendment proposes to delete the one-half mile spacing requirement between Family Care Homes. WT-172.

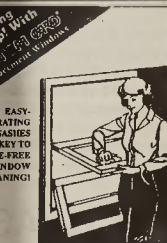
2. Proposal to amend Section 25-6.(G) of the City Code to require a Special Use Permit Authorized by the Board of Aldermen for "Laboratories (Analytical, Experimental, Testing, Research and Development) in all permitted industrial zoning districts and eliminate these uses in the B-2, B-2-S and B-3, B-3-S Zoning Districts. This text amendment will eliminate "Laboratories (Analytical, Experimental, Testing, Research and Development) in the B-2, B-2-S, and B-3, B-3-S Zoning Districts and require a Special Use permit authorized by the Board of Aldermen in all the permitted industrial districts. WT-173.

Prior to the hearing, interested persons may obtain any additional information which is in the possession of the City/County Planning Board in that office at City Hall on weekdays, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
