ole in stopping its spread. He lenies that his belief is pessimistic, alling it rather, "absolute realism." Afro-Americans who are choosing o attend white churches, he said, ire forgetting that those same thurches have been instruments in serpetuating racism throughout his-

"The vast majority of black "The vast majority of black hurches have a firm understanding of the racist ethos and they know hat racism could not have existed or so long without churches letting to that way. We couldn't have had his much racism without the cooperation of churches on both sides of he Atlantic."

Jones is more optimistic about the survival and maintenance of the black church. He is confident that he black church will continue to be the foundation and the cornerstone of the Afro-American community as a whole.

"The black church, because of "The black church, because of is affinity and closeness to the total ife experience of black people, will remain the cornerstone of black people," he said. "It's the oldest of all black institutions, the only place where the idea of bettering life for blacks is lifted up and it's the connecting rod between our history and pur hope for the future."
