Eight seniors in the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County school system have been selected as finalists for the annual Bruce Shelton Scholarship, a \$4,000 award.

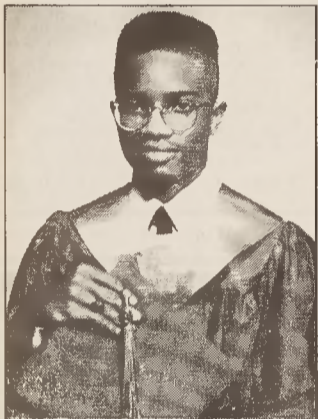

He has been president of his class in grades 10-12 and was named "1990 Male Athlete of the Year" by the *Winston-Salem Chronicle*. He plans to attend N. C. State University, majoring in Engineering.

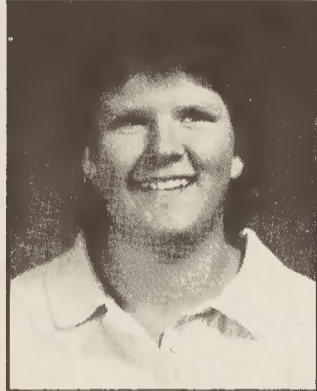

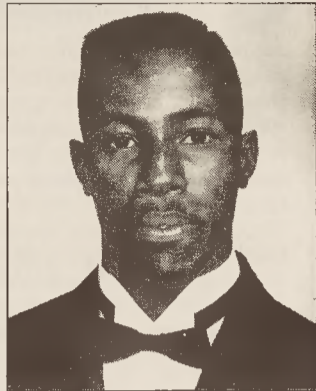

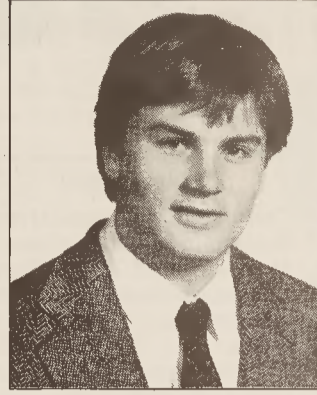

and two-time All-State in wrestling and captain of the wrestling team. All-Conference in soccer and soccer team co-captain, he plans to attend N. C. State University, majoring

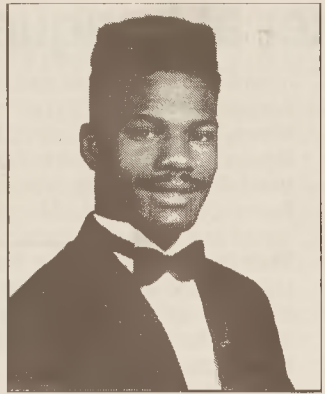
