Chambliss loses this case, even fewer blacks will graduate.

Do you think that the Justice Department cares? If blacks can't "compete" at white universities (where 7 out of 10 blacks never finish), let them flunk out, it explains in its legal brief.

Do you think the black liberal leaders who are wasting their precious resources in an emotional and, often, mean effort to keep Clarence Thomas, a black man, from being seated on the High Court care?

They're busy trying to keep the rest of us blacks on the liberal white plantation by scaring us into submission with their savagery towards Thomas.

His "thinking" is too "dangerous" they say.

If Thomas is not on the Supreme Court in November when Ayers Vs. Mabus is heard, fewer blacks will be thinking in American at all.
