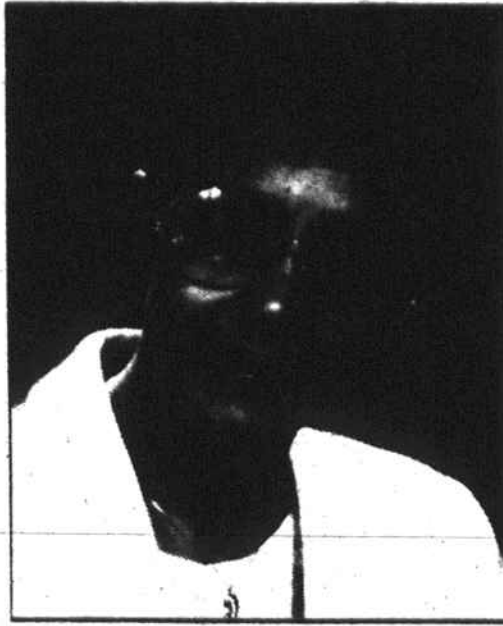

She has been an active member of the Winston-Salem Human Service community since 1989 and is well known for her position on strengthening the family, empowering black males, youth leadership and education. She has conducted a series of workshops, "Understanding the African-American Community," which dealt holistically with the entire "Psychology of Blackness."

"D," as she prefers to be called, has a diverse work background. She

has been a teacher, a lecturer, community leader, social worker and historian. She is a graduate of Adelphi University, where she received her B.S. degree in Social Work. She completed her graduate studies at Youngstown University, where she received her Masters Degree in Counseling.

"D" has received numerous awards for her volunteering with youth and the disadvantaged. She was the first female to hold the position of President/CEO of the Warren Trumbull Urban League in Warren, Ohio. She has also been the President of the Winston-Salem Urban League and is a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority.

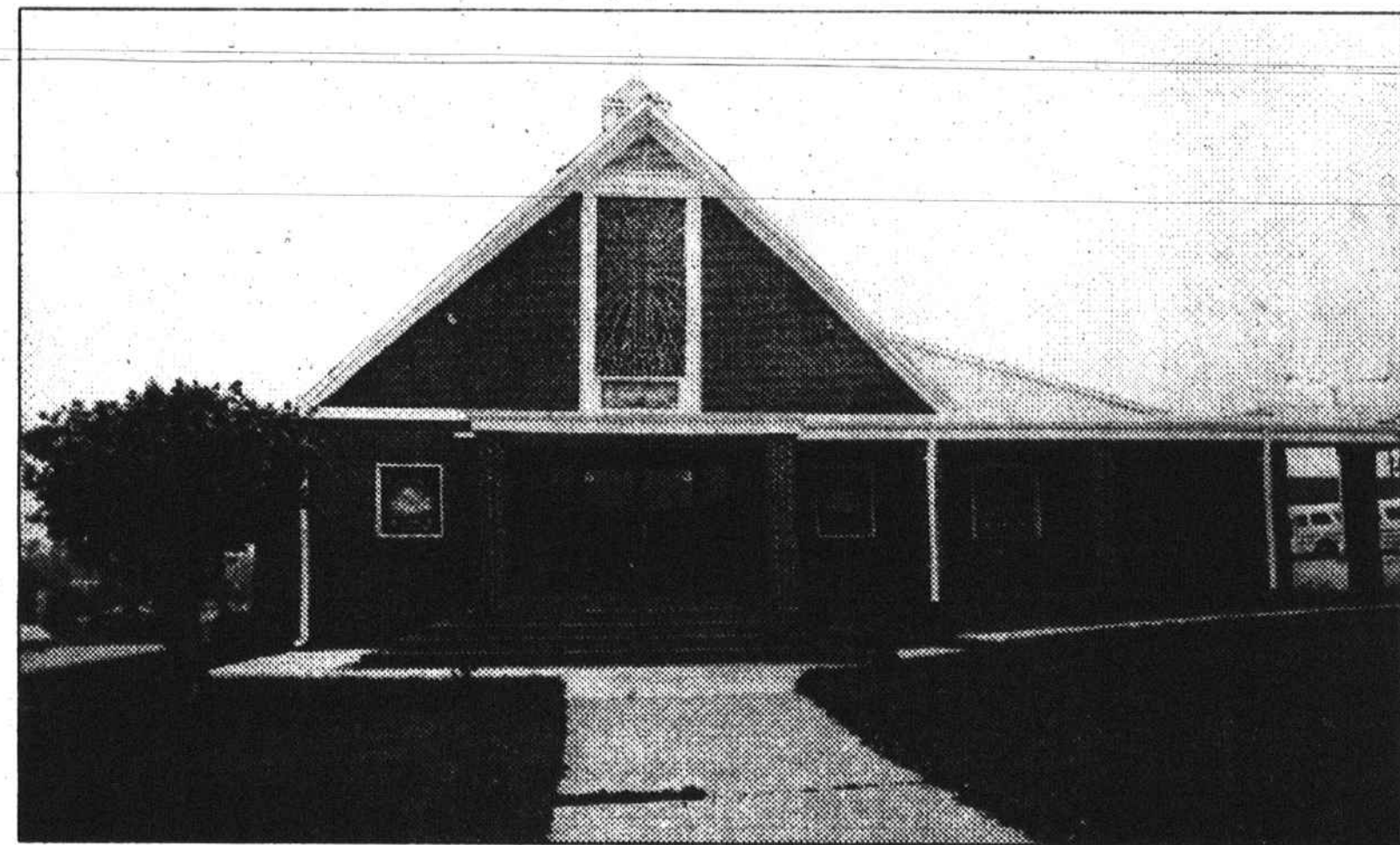
Music will be furnished by the Galilee Combine Women's Choir, under the direction of Mrs. Cynthia
