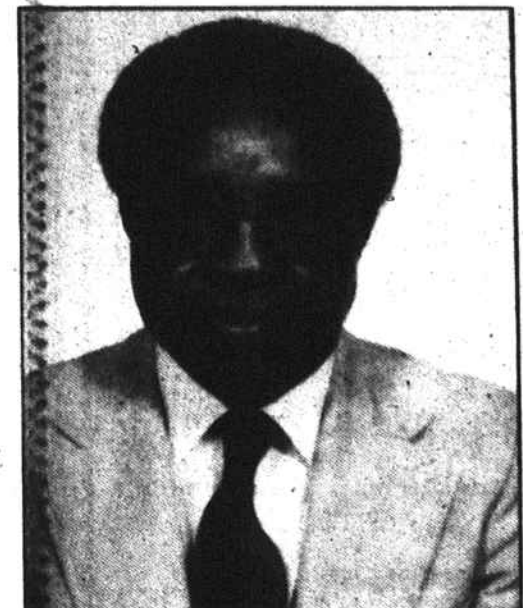
Forsyth Missionary and Education Union to meet

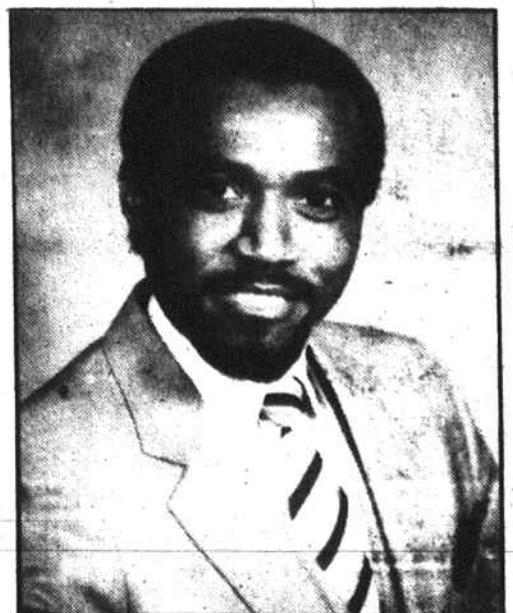
Dr. Lewis has traveled extensively throughout the United States and Canada. Other travel includes

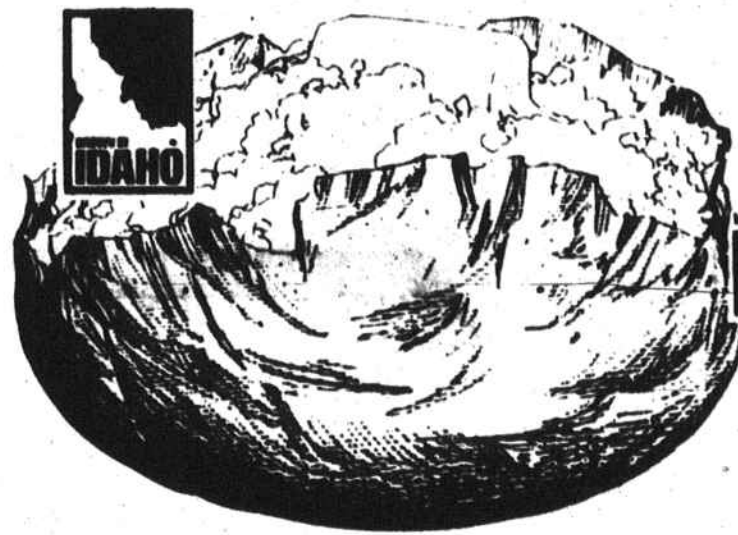
