talk with us." Burke added Tuesday that the interview with Sheppard and the four-member search committee was "totally informal." Sheppard left a resume with the committee which states that he is employed at Williams College - "1988 to present."

"I was under the impression that he was still at Williams," Burke said.

The interview with Sheppard centered "around more or less philosophical issues," Burke explained.

Besides Burke, the search committee includes Al Roseboro, the university's athletic director, Dr. Gerald McCants and Walter Marshall, an alumnus and Winston-Salem school board member.

Marshall was also under the impression that Sheppard was still working for Williams College.

"He told us he was on a layover between flights and was in a hurry to get back to his job," Marshall said.

But Sheppard simply said he answered the questions put to him.

"My resume hadn't been updated, but if they had asked me specific questions about it, I would have volunteered the information."

The deadline for receiving resumes was Dec. 30, and Burke said Tuesday that the committee had received 26. They hope to have that number down to three by Jan. 5. Those three names will then be sent to Chancellor Cleon Thompson, Burke said.
