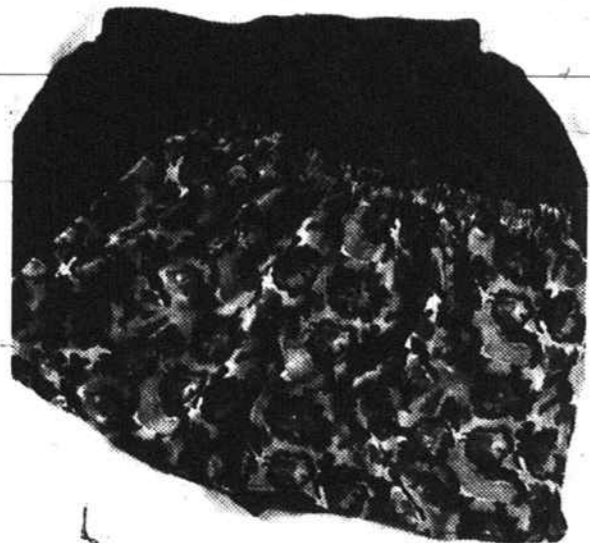

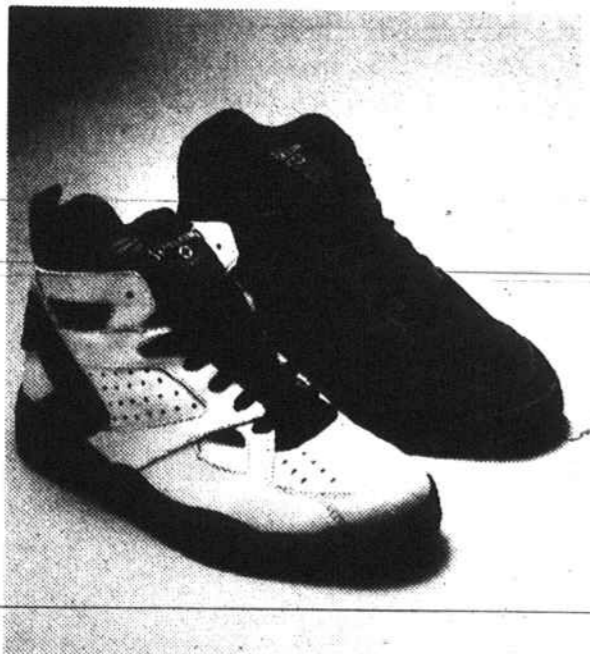
The cost of this pilot program is \$125.

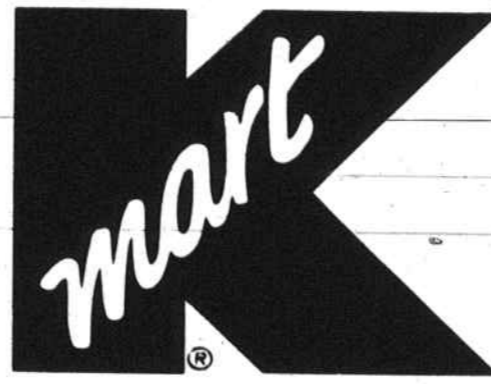
