

Mackie Golf Tournament Is a Success For Yet Another Year

The team of Jim Jones, Donnie Holt, Dave Bumgarner and Phil Beeson rolled a 10 under par 61 to capture the Martin M. Mackie Government Employees Golf Tournament held at the Winston Lake Golf Course last Saturday.

14 four-man teams representing Winston-Salem city employees played in the event originally named the City-County Golf Tournament, but changed its name in honor of the former city personnel supervisor who died in 1987. Martin was responsible for forming and scheduling employee-recreational activities during his tenure.

According to assistant city recreational director Tommy Gavin, the purpose of the tournament is to help bring the city's governmental agencies closer.

"There are more benefits to

playing in the tournament other than winning," he said.

Gavin said the event takes on a special meaning because of Mackie's physical handicap. Mackie was born unable to use his left arm but that did not deter him from competing in physical activity.

Although much has been changed and the results have been pleasant, Gavin thinks there is still room for improvement.

"I think the concept has a lot of potential," he said. "Next year, we are going to work on improving our marketing of the tournament."

All youth participating in other sports that desire to cheer in the YBA League must also attend the

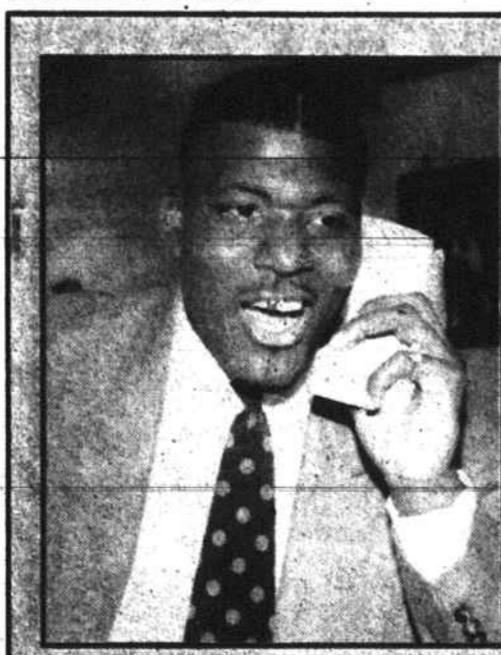
Nov. 14 meeting at their respective time scheduled. Those youths will be allowed to join their assigned squad at the expiration of the season of their current sports.
