MEAC Conference Announces its All-Conference Baseball and Softball Teams

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference has announced its All-Conference baseball and softball teams, along with the players and rookies of the year as voted by the league head coaches and sports information directors. The participants could not vote for their own players in the all-conference category.

All-MEAC baseball

Adrian Price of Coppin State, who currently leads NCAA Division I players with a .488 batting average, was voted MEAC player of the year. The junior designated hitter from Baltimore ranks second in the MEAC in runs-batted-in (39 in 41 games), doubles (12) and fifth in home runs (7).

Derrick Payne of Delaware State was tabbed MEAC rookie of the year. The first/third baseman from Alexandria, Va., batted .422 in 29 games for second-best in the MEAC.

The All-MEAC outfield includes Randall Pannell of Florida A&M (Sr.; New Orleans), Fred Neal of B-CC (Sr.; Barnwell, S.C.), and Ricky Farley of Maryland Eastern Shore (Sr.; Baltimore).

The All-MEAC catcher was Rodrick Neal of Bethune-Cookman (Sr.; Barnwell, S.C.).

The designated hitter was Mike Sullivan of Florida A&M (Jr.; Tampa). The pitcher was Shohn Lewis of Florida A&M (Jr.; Newnan, Ga.).

ALL-MEAC Softball Team

Psauntia Andrews, star pitcher of FAMU, was named the MEAC player of the year after leading the Rattlerettes to the league championship and winning a conference-best 20 games. The senior from Detroit also led the MEAC in strikeouts and earned run average.

Vickie Kelson of Morgan State was selected MEAC rookie of the year after batting .365 in 29 games, knocking in 25 runs, and stealing 22 of 22 bases. She is an infielder/catcher from Lanham, Md.

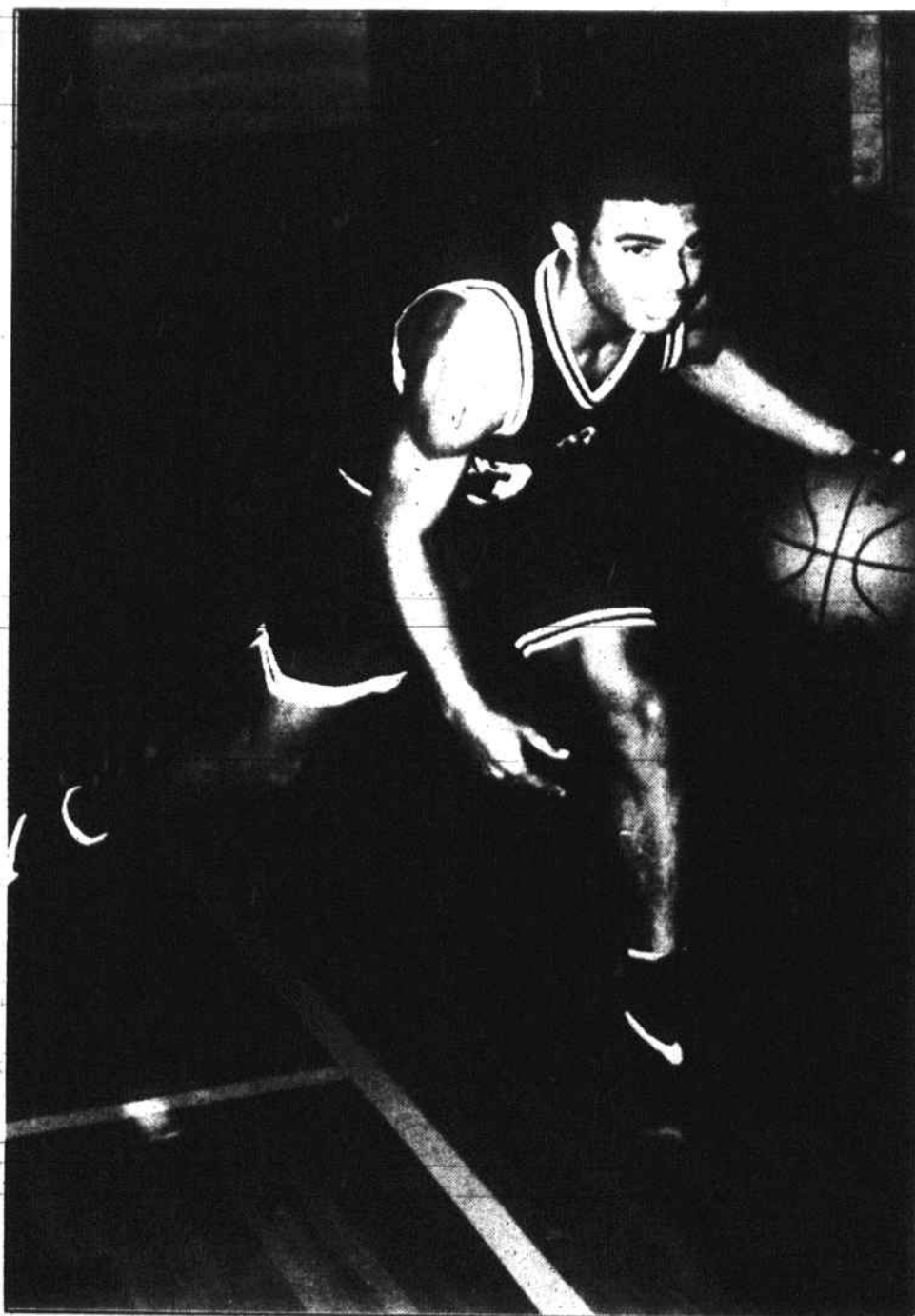
