

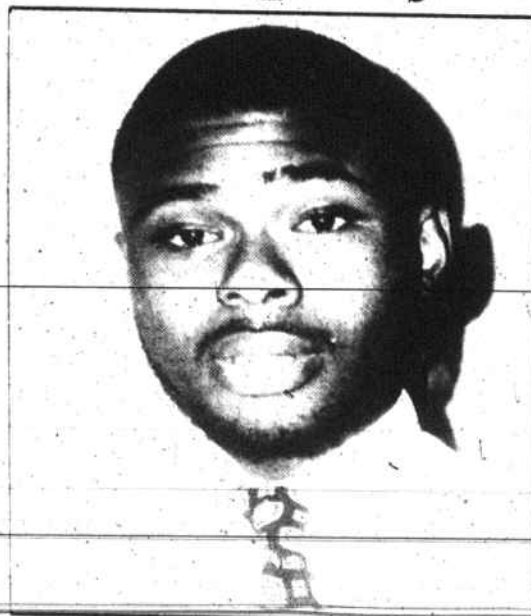
# Tannon Hardy Joins Mundy Realty Company
