

HAWS Renovates 10th Street Complex

The Winston-Salem Housing Authority celebrated the completed renovations of 10th Street Apartments with an open house.

Guests were able to view one of the 32 units while enjoying refreshments.

HAWS Executive Director Arthur Milligan said the Housing Authority bought the complex in 1990-1991 and decided to make it a model place for affordable housing.

With a loan from the city several changes were made in the then shabby complex. Air conditioners were put in all units, new water heaters, new floors and new roofs were added. Bathroom fixtures were refurbished and new paint and siding to give the units a new look.

"This is an example of what affordable housing can be," Milligan said. "And it does not always have to be subsidized."

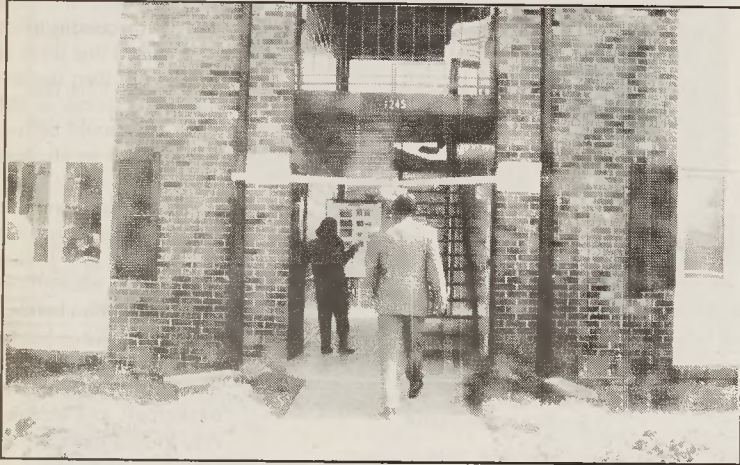
It also shows what can happen when there is cooperation between the Housing Authority and the City."


Hostesses for the meeting were Sorors Alice Smith and Isadora Springs.
