During his administration several organizations were established and many accomplishments made.

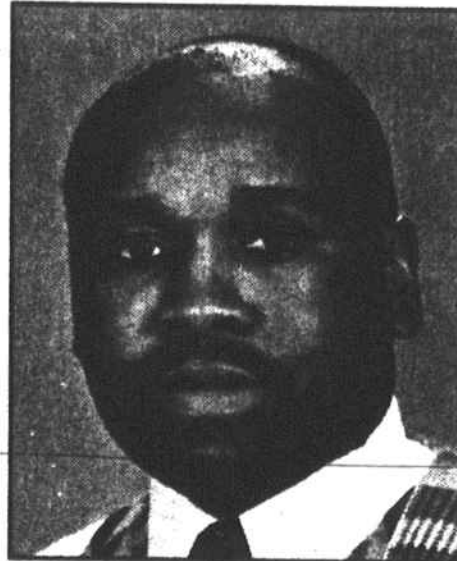
He is the father of three and has five grandchildren.
