Recycling is now more convenient than ever before for residents of Winston-Salem. On Friday, November 1, 1996, RECYCLE TODAY begins its expanded curbside recycling program. In addition to #1 and #2 clear plastic, steel cans, aluminum cans, newspaper, and all glass containers already being recycled, you can now recycle **telephone books, magazines, junk mail/mixed paper, and chipboard**. Chipboard includes your cereal boxes, cracker boxes, and any food box that does not have a waxed finish or is not cardboard. Paper products should be kept separate from other materials in a paper bag or additional bin.

You already should have received a door hanger with a brochure that has instructions for preparation of recyclables and your collection schedule. Because of the changes, some residents previously collected on Friday may miss collection on Friday November 1 or have overlapping collection. By recycling these additional materials, you can watch what you throw away shrink even more. You can make a difference.

HOW TO RECYCLE

Store recyclables in your green bin and place it at your curb by 7 a.m. each week.

Once your bin is emptied, please **remove** it from the curb and store it safely inside or near your home.

If you move, please leave the bin behind for the next resident. The bin is the property of the City of Winston-Salem.

Please mark your apartment number or letter on your green bin as soon as you receive it to avoid getting it mixed up with your neighbor's bin.

PAPER PRODUCTS

Chipboard includes cereal boxes, etc. Place dry, flattened and separate from aluminum. **NO boxes with a waxed finish.**

Glossy and non-glossy envelopes, office paper, paper bag or in additional bin. **NO plastic bags, or notebooks.**

Place phone book in additional bin separate from steel, plastic, and glass. **NO bags, plastic wrap, or**

Clean, dry, untied newspapers and their inserts. Place newspapers in brown paper bag or in additional bin separate from aluminum, steel, p

ALUMINUM - STEEL

Beer, soft drink and juice cans made of steel. Empty paint cans need to be removed. **NO paint cans.**



#1 and #2 clear plastic containers for recycling. No waxed boxes or paint cans.
