Samuels attended Winston-Salem State University, Shaw University, and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He is currently a senior at High Point University. Samuels has served as a member of the board of directors of the Crusaders for Christ Ministry Team, he is a member of the Board of Directors of the Saint Matthews Counseling Center, and has served as vice president of the Interdenominational Youth for Christ Fellowship of WSSU.

Monk. They have two children and one grandson. His wife, Gloria, is a well-known evangelist throughout the country and is also very active at the Church.
