

C. Legislative Black Caucus sets 12th Annual Conference

WGH — The N.C. Legislative Black Caucus will hold its Twelfth Annual Education and Weekend Conference May 30-31 at the Imperial Hotel & Center in Research Triangle Park, N.C. For the consecutive year, the Legislative Black Caucus will support the state's 11 historically black colleges and universities with thousands of scholarships. This year's chairman, Sen. Bill Hooper, is very excited about the opportunities this type of conference brings to the black

community. "This conference, in its entirety, is about strengthening the communities we serve by bringing people from every level to network and learn about ways to better improve the quality of life for everyone. That means reaching the different segments of the community including religious, political, educational, corporate, public and private, young and seasoned," he said.

The conference theme is "Our Legacy: Remembering, Renewing, Regenerating" The focus for the two-day event will be to take a look back at the contributions of black legislative leaders of the past, to renew and

strengthen commitments those leaders made in historically turbulent times to be a strong voice for the concerns of all citizens, and to generate some "new blood" into the legislative process through the youth who are invited to participate in this conference.

The guest speakers line-up includes Rep. Cynthia McKinney of Georgia's 11th District. McKinney won a 22-county sweeping landslide in 1992. She is most active in civil rights issues, including economic opportunities for minority and women-owned businesses. McKinney is a graduate of the University of

Southern California and is a doctoral candidate at Tufts University. She serves with the Congressional Black Caucus, and is a member of the National Council of Negro Women, among other memberships.

The conference format includes workshops, a town hall meeting, corporate reception sponsored by some of North Carolina's biggest industries, a banquet, youth forum, and prayer breakfast, with points of entertainment to enhance the tone of the moment. A highlight at the end of the conference is the awarding of scholarships to the colleges, universities, and some

select students. Sen. Jeanne Lucas and Rep. Larry Womble, chairpersons of the conference, the other members of the N.C. Legislative Black Caucus Foundation, cordially invite everyone to attend the conference, but also strongly encourage people who are concerned about their economic well-being in the 21st century, to attend. The members take the position that they must all work together now to position themselves for the next century so that their communities are not left behind.
