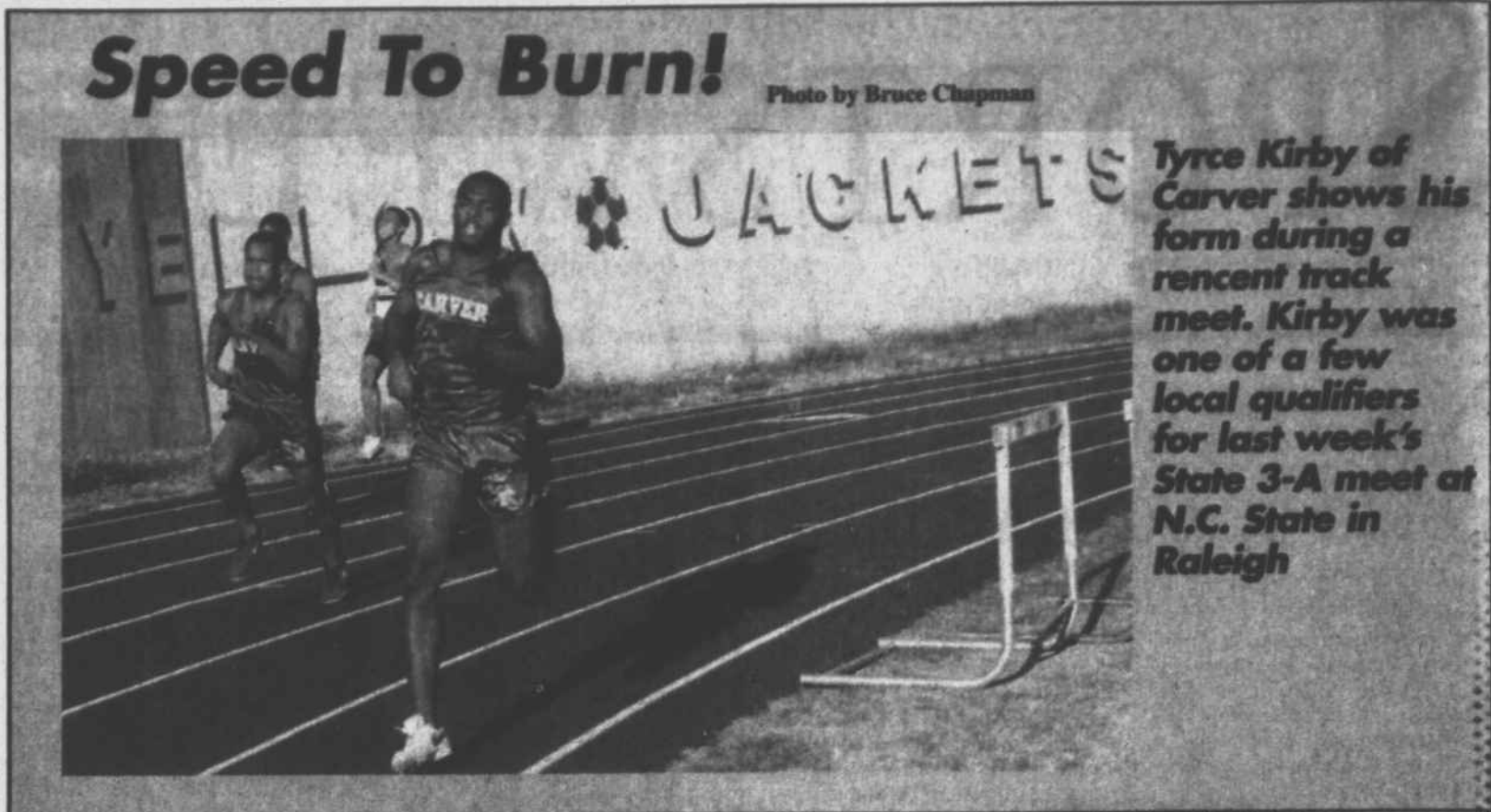
should work to NCCU's benefit. The Eagles won't have to travel nearly as the Rams do for the annual games.

First of all, playing the game at a "neutral" site helps. Raleigh's

Carter-Finley Stadium is indeed a venue that excites fans far and near. Added to that is the fact that Coach Bill Hayes of A&T played at NCCU. And the game pairs a Division II program against a Division I-AA squad.

In the case of NCCU-WSSU, there aren't nearly as many side bars working. But in a time that reaping financial benefits is important to WSSU, maybe the proper steps will be taken to adequately nurture and promote the game. But if not, this might be another in a long line of bone-headed decisions.
