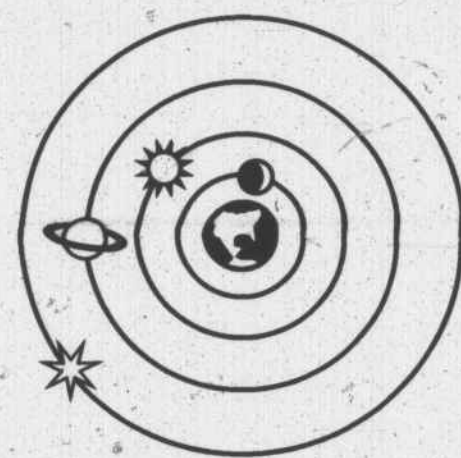
The most effective deterrent to drug use among kids **isn't the police, or prisons, or politicians.** One of the most
