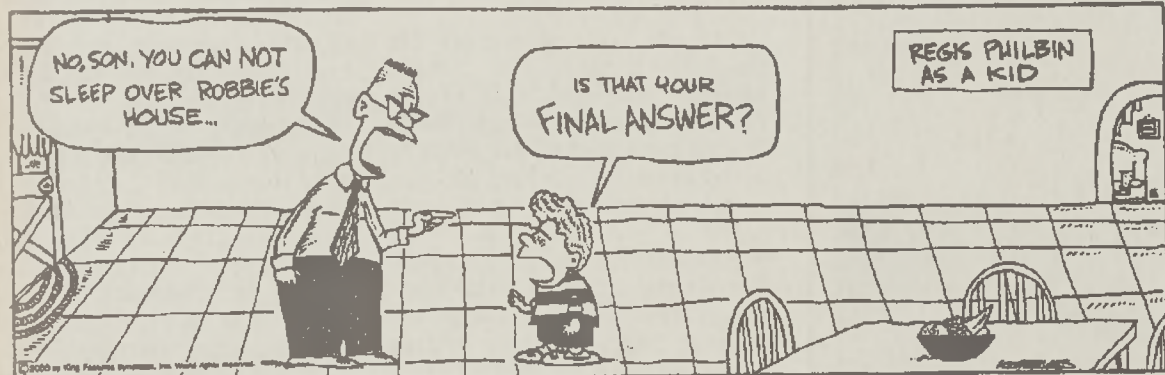

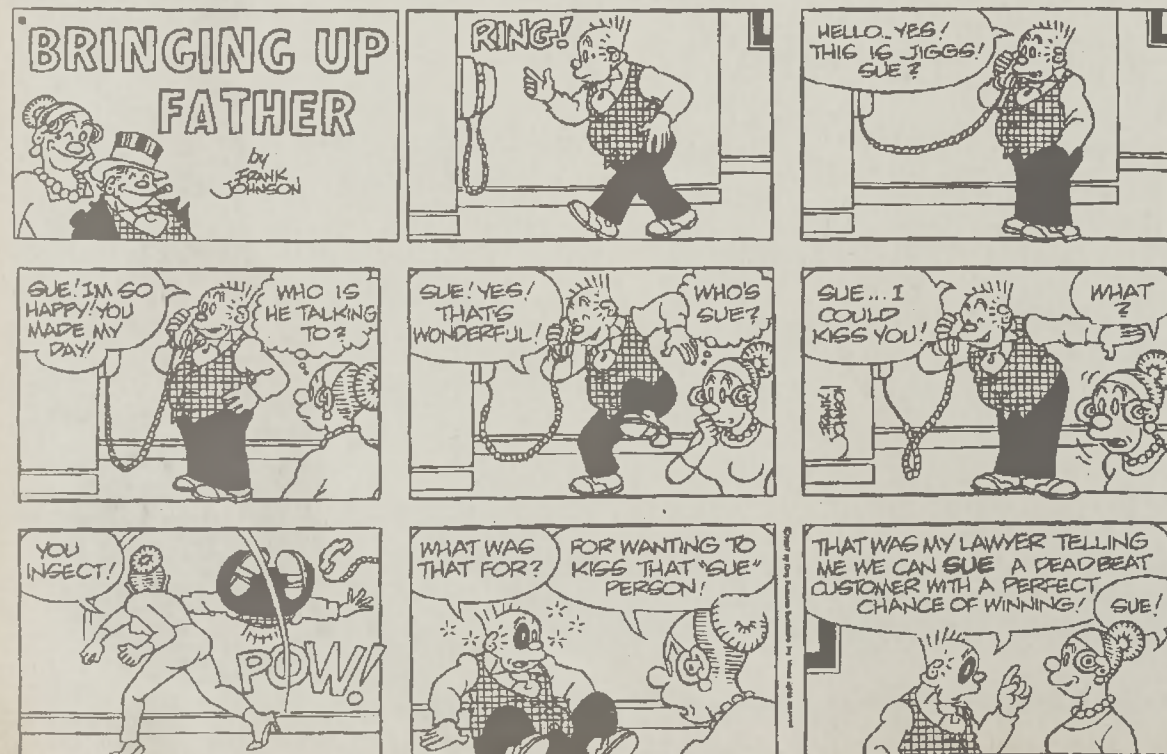

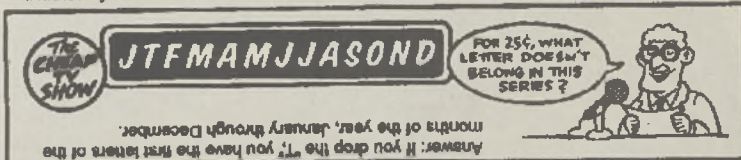

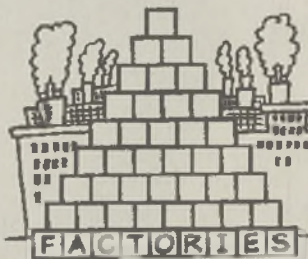
A SNOWY SECRET! What grows down in the winter? Connect the dots and find out.
