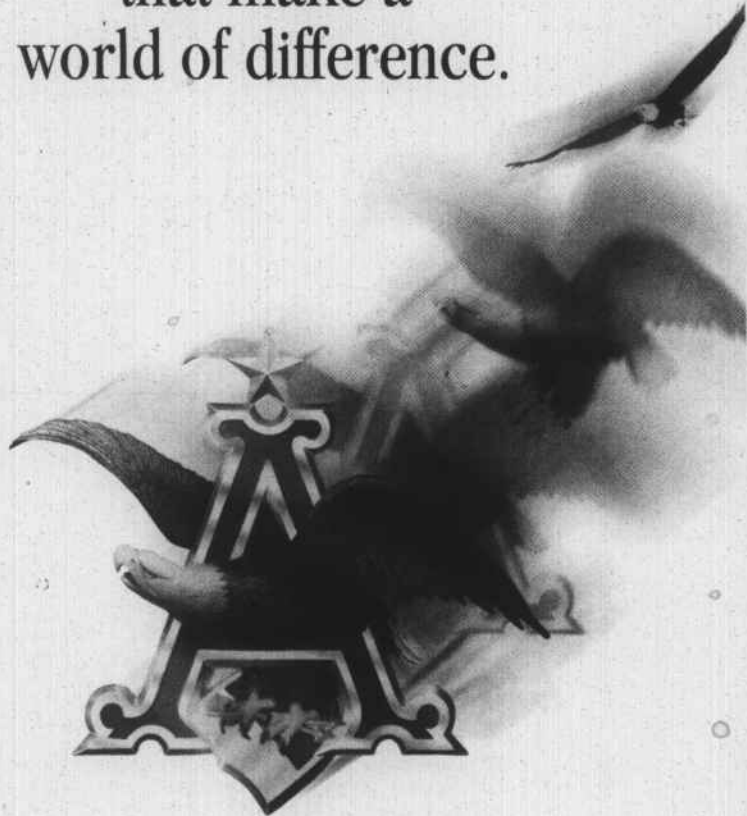
and by MotherRead/FatherRead of Forsyth County.

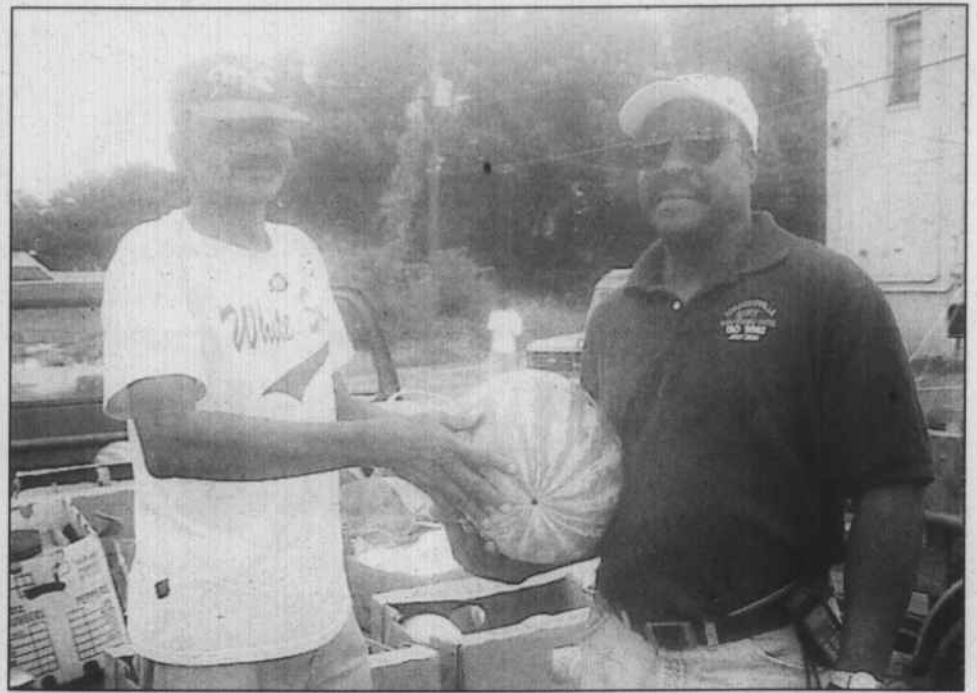
