

Report directly to the Chancellor. Lead and maintain a creative and energetic team of 10 direct reports and multiple external strategic suppliers. Develop the University's marketing and communication plan, public relations, print and electronic communications, media planning and placement, graphic design, interactive communications, website management, project management, graphic identity, photographic and photoproduction, publications, media relations and traffic and logistics. Plan, direct, coordinate and execute all aspects of the University's strategic branding, marketing and communications plans and policies. Support successful student recruitment efforts in collaboration with the Associate Vice Chancellor for Undergraduate Enrollment, Director of Graduate Studies Enrollment, the Division of Lifelong Learning enrollment units and the academic dean. Work closely with the Chancellor, the Vice Chancellor for University Advancement, and the Senior Management Team, on media strategy and marketing efforts in support of enrollment management and fundraising.
