

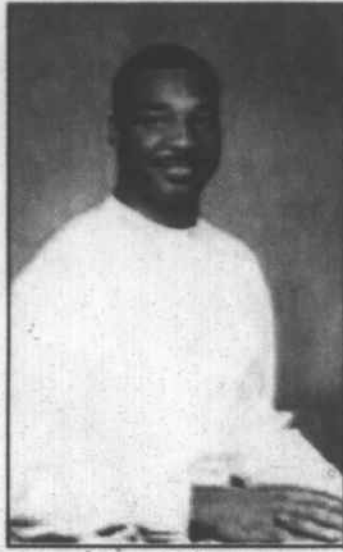
# Former Aggie b-ball captain to speak at Men's Day program
