THE LOFTY STANDARDS FOR DEACONS

Lesson Scripture: Acts 6:1-

Lesson Aims: To understand why and how the first deacons were chosen, to recognize and appreciate the standards for selection of leaders (deacons), and to be ready to serve having the right criteria.

Background: In last week's lesson, a number of places were mentioned where many Jews in Jerusalem for Passover and Pentecost came from. After hearing Peter preach, many converted carried the message back to their homes. The number of converts continued to grow. For the most part, the early converts came from the Jewish faith (Judaism). Those Jews living outside of Judah (Judea or Palestine) spoke the languages (also last week) of that area. However, Jews that lived in Judah felt that they were just a little bit better than the others. You see, from their perspective, they didn't have any outside influence, therefore they were the traditional ones! That mentality continued to thrive, even though some of them converted. The lesson opens sometime after the Day of Pentecost.
