

Anthony: Are you the best defensive back in college football this year?

Alphonso: No, I'm not. Anthony: What?

Alphonso: Uh, no. I don't pay attention to that. I'm just thinking about my senior season. You can't get drafted if you don't have a good senior season. Everything else will take care of itself.

Anthony: Well, how has your senior season been going for you?

Alphonso: It's been all right. It hasn't been as good as I anticipated. I anticipated an undefeated season right now. I set my goals pretty high in the off season. The entire team set high goals. We still have four more games. So, we still have a chance at having a great sea-

Anthony: Definitely. The ACC race is so close. Do you look at what other teams need to do before each game to put you guys in a better position, or do you simply worry about Wake?
