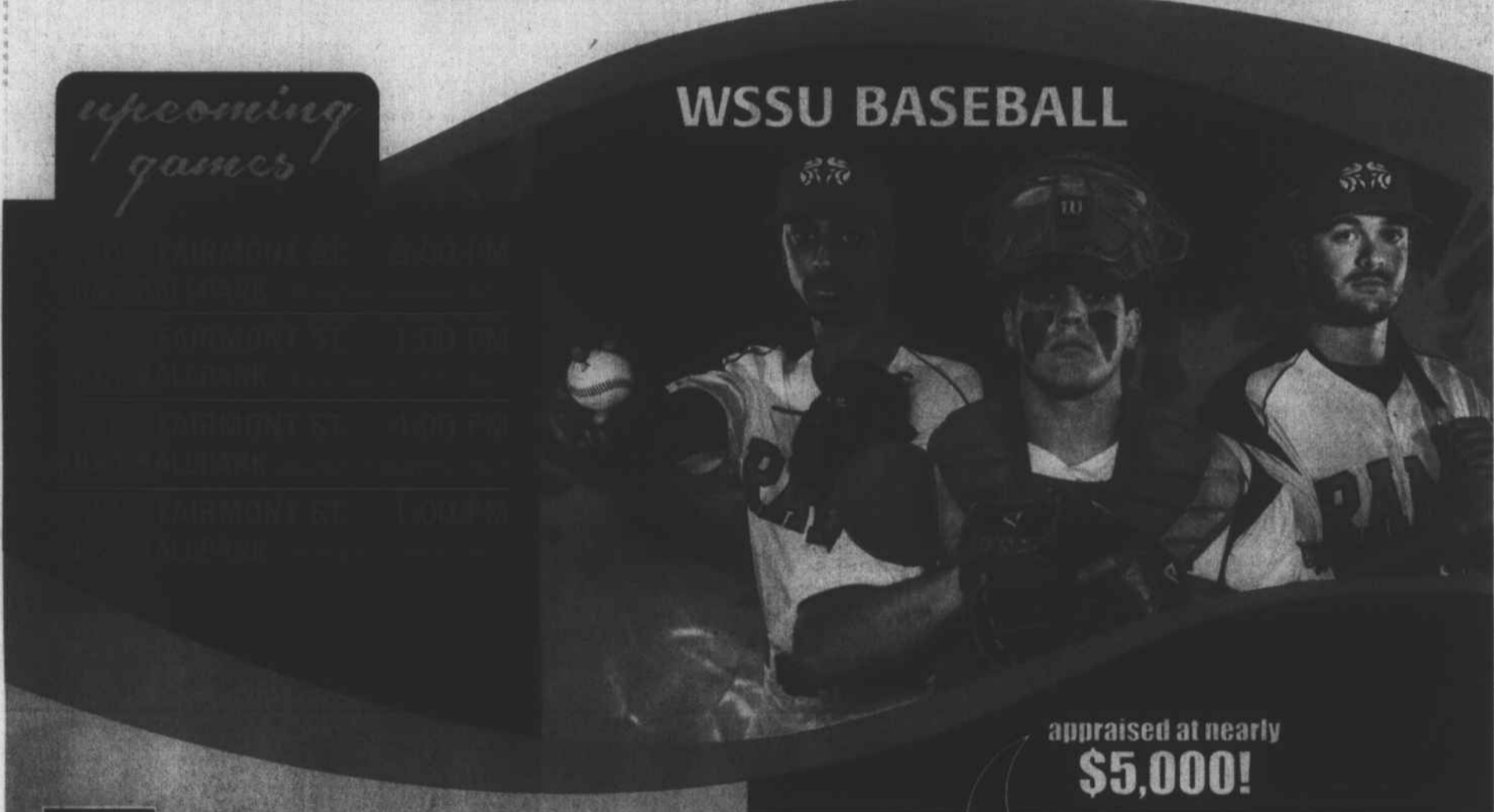

RAFFLING OFF A PIECE OF LUNAR HISTORY

The Winston-Salem State University Foundation is proud to raffle off a stunning Omega Speedmaster Moonwatch Professional wristwatch. The Omega Company describes this as an iconic timepiece that has been a part of six lunar missions.

This brand new Omega Speedmaster Moonwatch, which is still in its original box, has been appraised at nearly \$5,000. It has a dial that is black with baton index hour markers accented with Super Luminova. Fitted to the round case is a hesalite crystal surrounded by a black aluminum bezel with tachymeter indications. Internally, the watch is fitted with 17 jewel Swiss made mechanical hand wound movement with chronograph functions. This model of watch has been retired.

The red leather watch presentation case has been signed by astronauts Scott Carpenter and Charles Duke, Jr. Carpenter, who is now deceased, was one of the original seven astronauts selected for NASA's Project Mercury. He was the second American—after John Glenn—to orbit the Earth. Duke was a Lunar Module Pilot for Apollo 16. He was the tenth person to walk on the Moon.

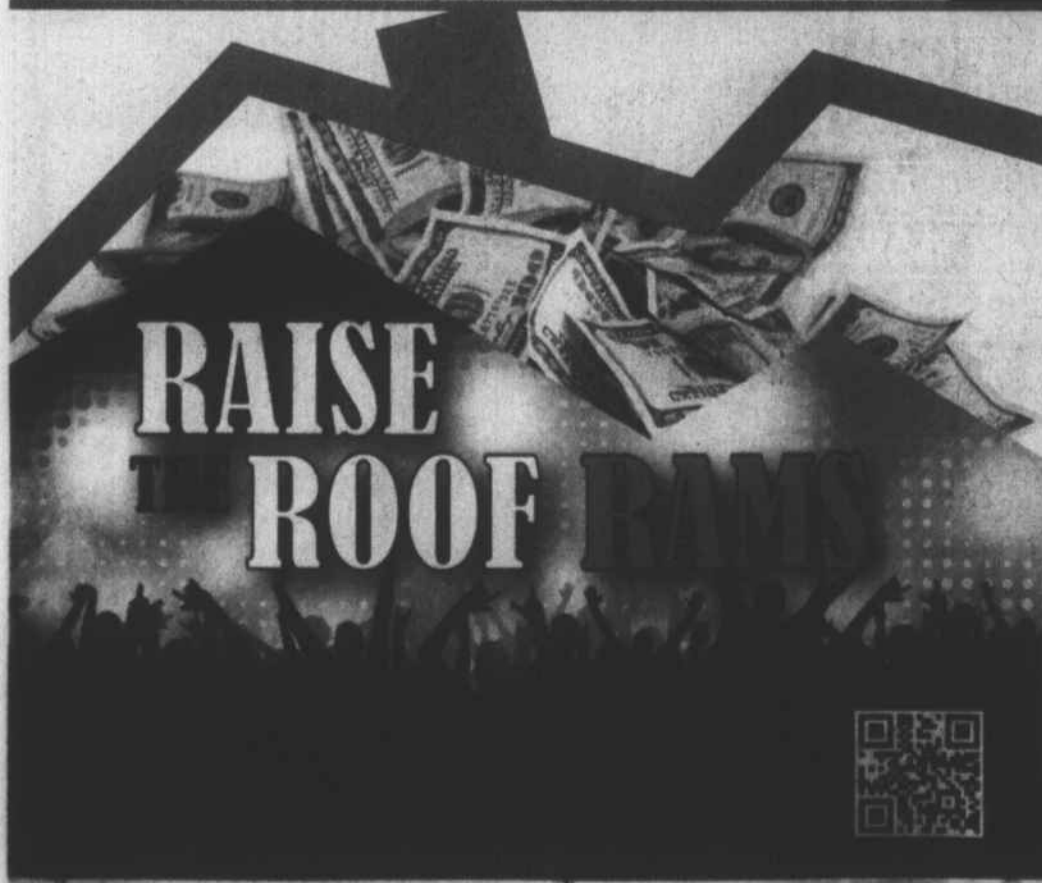
