TRADING WEAK ON STOCK MARKET

Railway Labor Condition and Mexican Situation Cause Caution; Bonds Continue Irregular.

(By The Associated Press) New York, June 15.—The stock market was in the doldrums during the greater part of today's irregular session, dealings tapering off to the smallest total of recent weeks.

Interesting war shares were temporarily revived by strength of Crucible Steel, but other munitions, equipments and specialties of kindred character hesitated, with an almost equal distribution of nominal gains and losses.

Of all the leaders, United States Steel exhibited greatest steadiness, hovering about its recent best price.

Bethlehem Steel made an advance of 5 1/2 points, gaining that much of its quarterly dividend of 1 1/2 per cent.

Bonds were irregular, with total sales, par value, \$4,430,000.
