Dr. E. B. Branson Addresses Woman's Club

The members of the Woman's Club who were present on yesterday at the open meeting to hear Dr. E. B. Branson speak upon the subject of "Civic Housekeeping" enjoyed a rare opportunity to hear the facts concerning a subject that should be of the greatest interest to every woman who loves humanity, or her neighbor.

Dr. Branson paid a most gallant tribute to women, saying that many frightful conditions within our state went continually from bad to worse, until the women of the state awoke to the fact and began to realize the situation, saying that men were either too busy after building wonderful cities and institutions, or else lacked the discriminating insight into the modern operandi of civic cleanliness—for these reasons or for some other, good housekeeping had ever been relegated to the women, and it was so in public as in private housekeeping. Dr. Branson said that in many counties there were no provisions for taking care of tubercular patients, that Wake county alone had twice as many patients afflicted with the dread disease as there were beds in the sanitarium. He congratulated our own county upon its tubercular hospital, and urged the need of a detention house

HOCH OFFERS PLAN TO SAVE NEWSPRINT PAPER

Washington, Dec. 17.—A new plan to conserve the scanty supply of print paper was proposed in a bill introduced today by Representative Hoch, Republican, Kansas after the committee's decision on the Anthony measure. The Hoch bill would restrict all newspapers and periodicals from using more paper during the first six months of 1920 than was used during the first half of 1919. The restriction would take into consideration increased circulation and provision would be made for new publications. Under the Hoch bill designed as a substitute for the Anthony measure no publisher would be given the second class mailing privileges without filing a pledge to observe the limitation, and violators would suffer the penalty of paying third class postage rates. Representative Anthony and other members of the postoffice committee were said to favor the Hoch bill in view of the many objections raised to the Anthony measure.

BARUCH URGES INDUSTRIAL PREPARATION FOR WAR

Washington, Dec. 17.—Peace time industrial preparedness for war was recommended by Bernard M. Baruch, former chairman of the war industries board, in a report to President Wilson, which was submitted to congress. Encouragement by the government of the mining of essential war materials, the preservation of skeleton munition plants, and the creation of a skeleton organization similar to the war industries board, were the specific recommendations made by Mr. Baruch.

HOUSE VOTES TO SELL GOVERNMENT WAREHOUSES

Washington, Dec. 17.—Without a dissenting vote, the house passed and sent to the senate today a bill ordering the sale of housing facilities erected by the government during the war to relieve congestion in many industrial centers. The measure also abolishes the United States

housing bureau, transferring the properties to the treasury for sale to private persons, either for cash or part payments. Debate on the measure centered largely in an attack on the housing bureau. Charges of profligate expenditures of government funds were made by several members and the assertion was made that the senate public buildings committee was conducting an invest-
