THE ANNUAL NEW YEAR'S EVE SERVICES AT THE HOME CHURCH ARE SCHEDULED AS FOLLOWS: AT 4 O'CLOCK THIS AFTERNOON THE CHILDREN'S SINGING SERVICES; AT 8 O'CLOCK THIS EVENING THE MEMORIAL SERVICE WILL BE READ BY BISHOP ROTHBARGER, AND AT 11:30 P.M. MIDDLETOWN, OR WATCH SERVICE, WILL BE HELD. ALL THESE SERVICES ARE ALWAYS LARGELY ATTENDED.

AS INDICATED BY TREASURY FIGURES OF COLLECTIONS FROM VARIOUS SOURCES, WITH THE LAST FOUR DAYS OF THE YEAR NOT YET TABULATED RECEIPTS FROM TAXES, CUSTOMS AND MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE AMOUNTED TO \$4,687,667,000, OF WHICH \$2,849,925,000 CAME FROM INCOME AND EXCESS PROFITS TAXES ALONE. \$1,124,538,000 FROM OTHER FEDERAL TAXES; ONLY \$177,000,000 FROM CUSTOMS DUTIES ON IMPORTS AND THE BALANCE, OR ABOUT \$638,000,000, HAS COME INTO THE TREASURY FROM THE FOURTH LIBERTY LOAN. IN ADDITION \$13,000,000,000

TO TAKE ON BOARD SICK AMERICANS

COPENHAGEN, Dec. 26.—American warships which arrived here yesterday will leave today for German ports on the Baltic Sea where they will take on board sick Americans.
